A special theatre was built in London for Shakespeare's plays, which opened in 1599. Unfortunately it burnt down in 1613, so another one was built the next year. However this one was destroyed in 1644 by people who did not like plays.

It was not until 1997 that it was built again, and Shakespeare's plays are performed in this theatre today.
